The centuries by A N Cook (Essex) and S R Patel (Notts) v New Zealand in 2003/04 represent the first occasion when two centurions were at the wicket together for England in the U19 World Cup. They added an unbroken 3rd wicket stand of 164.

The second occasion occurred at the M A Aziz Stadium, Chittagong, when D W Lawrence (Essex) and J T A Burnham (Durham) added 303 for the 2nd wicket in 2015/16.
