The son of Billy (10249 runs and 874 wickets for Yorkshire and 15 Test Matches for England) and father of Ted (player for and manager of Southampton FC), he never quite established himself in his native Yorkshire side. So he moved to Glamorgan, where runs and wickets came. His first season in Wales coincided with Glamorgan's inaugural season in the Championship in 1921. He also played Minor Counties cricket with Cheshire.

He had been a professional for the Briton Ferry CC in 1914 and it was from there that he linked up with Glamorgan. Unfortunately, in 1931, Glamorgan had to dispense with his services, as financial problems resulted in a reduced professional staff. He later played for Broughton Hall CC in Cheshire, for whom he also played in the Minor Counties Championship. He also coached in Ireland and played football for Bolton Wanderers and Leeds City FC.

He rivalled his father in elegance of attire and became known as "The Marquis" after his father had been known as "The Duke"

48) **Percy CLARKSON** – Born in 1882 in Halifax, W Yorks

Yorkshire career – 1903 to 1905. This involved just two games. His highest score (37) came against Notts Colts at Wath-upon-Deane Athletic Gd on 25 & 26 May 1905

He played for the second eleven at the age of 19 in 1900, and then played one game for the first eleven but then left the county. He spent the rest of his cricketing life in club cricket, with the Heckmondwike and Dewsbury clubs.
