He was educated at St Edwards School, Oxford and Cambridge Un. He received his Yorks cap in 1936 and, after moving to Essex in 1951, he was capped immediately. He is the only player to score a century in his first game for Yorks (157*) v Notts at Bramall Lane Sheffield on 27-30 July 1935 and in his first test match (as above).

After finishing his playing days, he spent 10 years as an Umpire and no-balled Harold Rhodes (Derbys) six times for throwing in the tourist match against the South Africans at Derby on 7-10 May 1960.
