The aggregate attendance at the Lancashire v. Surrey match last week end must have reached 32,000. Surrey succeeded in beating the home county by 207 runs.

The defeat has resulted under unusually depressing circumstances, and the winners may congratulate themselves on a victory won, not by merit alone, but by good fortune. We do not wish to minimise the form of Surrey, but they themselves will acknowledge that Dame Fortune has been in their favour all along the line. The Lancastrians had all the worst of the luck in this match, the most unfortunate piece of business being the enforced absence after Thursday of Watson and Briggs, the former, who should have gone in to bat yesterday morning, having "absent ill" written against his name in the score book. Watson is likely to be in for a pretty long spell of inactivity, as he, unfortunately, is in bed suffering from a rupture in the left side, and the wonder is how he managed to bowl 47 overs on the opening day in such a state, as the rupture was of a day or two's standing unknown. Briggs turned up yesterday, but was so bad he had to be sent home, the influenza fiend having got him in his grasp.

Leicestershire, after playing a rattling game with the Surrey team, and scoring 400 in one innings in their match with Derbyshire, entered into cricket combat with the broad-acred shire on Thursday last week. Rain, however, prevented the match from being finished, and the scores stood at—Yorkshire, first innings, 110; second, 53 for six wickets; Leicestershire, first innings, 52; second, 63 for five wickets.

The Leicestershire team are apparently taking after their captain, Mr C. E. de Trafford, who is unquestionably one of the hardest hitters of the present day, and after their last fine performance we shall be curious to see what Leicestershire do in their other matches this season.

Although Kent had only managed to put up the rather modest total of 120 runs, yet it was more than sufficient by eight runs to account for both the innings of the Middlesex men, who only scored 68 and 44 in their first and second ventures respectively.

Casey played steadily for 11, but none of the other batters particularly distinguished themselves, the innings eventually closing for 144 runs.

The Pall Mall Gazette, in what it is pleased to call "Cricket Notes," actually falls foul of Mold because he bowls too fast. "A few more cricketers rendered useless by Mold," says this Cockney organ, "and he may be forced by public opinion to give up the ball or moderate his pace.
