Kent was represented by a strong team, the players including Mcrfee, Preston, Jennings, and L. H. W. Troughton, all of whom have played for the first eleven this year. The game began at 11.30, Kent batting. Collings and Jennings went in first, but they were soon separated, Jennings being caught by P. J. Paravicini. The wicket fell for 16 runs. Snowdon joined Collins, and these two carried the score to 50. A good stand was made by Troughton and Snowdon, who knocked up 112 runs, so that at the fall of the third wicket Kent had 162 to their credit. Snowdon made 69 and Troughton 71. There was another period of bright cricket with Powell and Hosie batting, the pair carrying the score to 231. Hosie was the next to be dismissed, his total being 21. Powell made a longer stay, and scored 46 runs. Morfee was caught for 5, and Roberts for 8. Hickmott, however, batted splendidly, his 41 not out being very useful. Preston and Smith made low scores. Altogether Kent obtained 321 runs, which made Buckinghamshire's chances of winning rather small. Scoring was somewhat slow at the start, but was very fast at the finish.


