Surrey replied to the Kent total with a score of 142, to which C. E. Nicol, with 33, was the highest contributor. Six of the other lastemen reached double figures and Geary, who was second top scorer, carried out his bat with 26. The innings came to an analysis to the contributor with a contributor wit and about ten minutes past six and Kent had ten minutes batting before stamps were drawn for the day, during which time they scored eight without loss.

During Monday night heavy rain fell and made play impossible on the following day.
